She worked as an event planner at Lucky Lux's Luxury Events, Occasions, and Experiences and was the President of the Florum of Fantasy Book Club. She was known for her charisma, speed-reading, and craftiness as well as her allergies to strawberries, azaleas, and soot.

You now have a choice to make. Pick one choice and remember the selection title.

1. You decide to stay and help solve the murder.
2. You decide to stay and see what happens.
3. You decide to stay and cause some mischief.

Once you have made your decision you may proceed to learn more about the suspects.

Suspect Slides

Alex Dale-Douglas is a late twenty-something with a breezy demeanor and foggy memory. She is a baker at Lucky Lux's Luxury Grocery, Market, and Goods and Secretary of the Florum of Fantasy Book Club. Daphne was her best friend and secret love interest. Alex's possible motive for murder would be to halt Daphne's impending engagement to a spouse of her parents choosing.

Benny Nelson is in his late twenties with a serious tone and perfect pitch. He is an event coordinator at Lucky Lux's Luxury Events, Occasions, and Experiences and Vice President of the Florum of Fantasy Book Club. Daphne was his co-worker. Benny's possible motive for murder would be to reduce the competition for an upcoming senior promotion that Daphne had also been eligible for.

Celeste Summers is in her early-thirties (ish) with a biting sarcasm and expensive taste. She is a personal stylist at Lucky Lux's Luxury Clothing, Attire, and Costumes and Treasurer of the Florum of Fantasy Book Club. Daphne was her cousin. Celeste's possible motive for murder would be to, without Daphne, enable a claim to the entire extensive Millers family inheritance.

You now have a choice to make. Pick one choice and remember the selection title.

A.You think you know who committed the murder and are ready to turn them in as soon as you have evidence.

B.You are unsure who committed the murder and will stick around to see the evidence.

C. You think you know who committed the murder but will not turn them in regardless of the evidence.

Once you have made your decision you may proceed to view a piece of evidence. You may only examine ONE.

If the culprit might be Alex, view Evidence Number 1.

If the culprit might be Benny, view Evidence Number 2.

If the culprit might be Celeste, view Evidence Number 3.

Evidence Slides

The evidence consists of a small bouquet with an assortment of flowers in a vase. The bouquet was a gift to Daphne and was used as a centerpiece for the Florum of Fantasy Book Club meeting. It may have contributed to her death as it contains a hidden flower.

You now have a choice to make. Pick one choice and remember the selection title.

Rose. You are assured of the culprit's undeniable guilt and are ready for justice.

Marigold. You are certain of the culprit.

Dandelion: You already knew who the culprit was and laid out a trap to catch them red-handed.

Sage. You believe others will ensure the culprit faces justice.

Periwinkle. You do nothing with this new evidence.

Lilac. You realize you really do not know or care about these people and leave.

Peony. You will employ extreme measures to ensure the culprit is brought to justice however necessary.

Magnolia. You watch as the culprit slips away undetected.

Lily. You tamper with the evidence and frame another suspect so the culprit is not caught.

Once you have made your decision you may proceed to view the farewell video.

Ceylon. You do nothing with this new evidence.

Lavender. You realize you really do not know or care about these people and leave.

Peach. You will employ extreme measures to ensure the culprit is brought to justice however necessary.

Cinnamon. You watch as the culprit slips away undetected.

Vanilla. You tamper with the evidence and frame another suspect so the culprit is not caught.
